Letter of Intent to join the Global Alliance of Cities for Road Safety (ACRoS)

On behalf of the city of , I wish to state our intention to join UN-Habitat's Global Alliance of Cities for Road Safety (ACRoS) and commit to making efforts to:

- 1. **Assess and improve road safety conditions for all road users** by collecting and analysing data on road crashes, injuries, and fatalities to identify key risk areas.
- 2. Address the five pillars of the Safe System Approach and align road safety strategies to the goals of the UN Second Decade of Action for Road Safety and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly Goal 3.6 to halve road traffic deaths and injuries by 2030
- 3. **Promote road safety through safe and sustainable urban mobility** by focusing on improving conditions for public transport, cycling, and walking.
- 4. **Raise awareness on road safety issues** and encourage a culture of road safety and respect for traffic regulations.
- 5. **Collaborate with stakeholders** including civil society, private sector, and government agencies to develop comprehensive road safety strategies.
- 6. **Support vulnerable road users**, including pedestrians, cyclists, children, women, elderly, and people with disabilities, by creating more inclusive and safer street environments.
- 7. **Invest in capacity building and training** for local authorities, traffic police, and emergency responders to improve road safety management and response to accidents.
- 8. **Evaluate and adopt innovative technologies** such as smart traffic management systems, real-time data monitoring, and vehicle safety improvements to reduce accidents.
- 9. **Make long-term strategic plans** that integrate road safety into urban development projects, ensuring a holistic approach to urban mobility and infrastructure development.
- 10. **Report bi-annual progress** on the implementation of road safety measures and share success stories with the ACROS Secretariat.

We recognize that signing this letter of intent is not legally binding and does not imply any financial or legal obligations for either party. We further understand that by signing this letter, we authorize UN-Habitat to use and share data provided by the city in accordance with the UN Personal Data Protection and Privacy Policy.
